EXHIBITION ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility was open to all artists in Hawai'i.

All paintings were required to be 80 percent or more soft pastels. Oil pastels were not accepted. They were required to be original and of the artist's own design and must have been created independently within the last two years.

No work which had previously been shown in any juried exhibition or any PAH show, done in either a class or workshop, or copied from public material was eligible. Acceptance of unusual entries was at the juror's discretion.
